1. Please contact the Registration Coordinator (Lindsey Carlin, 301-525-7234, homeartslc@gmail.com) with any questions regarding entry procedures.
2. All items must be entered on-site during the dates and times listed above. Entries will not be accepted after Registration has ended. No entries will be accepted on Judging Day.
3. Online entering is not available.
4. Prior to Registration, please make sure that all entries follow both the Rules and Regulations of the Home Arts Department, and the rules of the appropriate Department within Home Arts. If you have any questions about your entries, please contact a Department Chairperson or Home Arts Superintendent.
5. Exhibitors with non-perishable entries may find registration faster on the first day of registration.
6. Please see catalog page 185 for Registration parking and drop-off procedures.
7. During Registration times listed, Home Arts volunteers will help exhibitors through the entire registration process. While it is helpful to know the department, division, and class for each entry, it is not necessary to determine these prior to registration. If you have any questions, please contact the Registration Coordinator.
8. If the exhibitor agrees to put an item into an age-restricted category (ages 17 years and under, or 70 years and older) the exact age of the exhibitor should be provided to the registrar and written on all exhibit tags.
9. Improperly categorized entries may be reclassified or not judged. Home Arts volunteers make every effort to ensure that all entries are placed in the proper categories, based on the information provided to them. Please contact the department chairperson with any questions about an entry.
10. To speed up the registration process, exhibitors are encouraged to provide self-adhesive return address labels for the registrars to attach to entry tags. Please make sure that the name of the individual who created the item is used on the tag (for example, Mama Doe's labels may be used for Child Doe, but Mama's name must be crossed out and Child's written in).
