one-day fashion design competition at the fair!**

Calling all fashionistas... come one, come all, to embrace your inner designer at this year's Project G Street. No fashion school needed. All skill levels, all ages are invited to show what you can do!

**Project G Street Rules:**

1. The 1<sup>st</sup> place team will win a \$300.00 gift card to G Street Fabrics, 2<sup>nd</sup> place team will win a \$200.00 gift card, and the 3<sup>rd</sup> place team will win a \$100.00 gift card. Win or lose, you'll take away amazing memories and fantastic social media content!
2. Teams must register by email: [kmndakota@gmail.com](mailto:kmndakota@gmail.com) or hand carry your entry form to the fair office at 16 Chestnut Ave., Gaithersburg, MD 20877 by end of day Wednesday, July 31<sup>st</sup>. The chairpersons will choose up to 8 teams for the 2024 Project G Street competition. Teams will be notified via email and text message on Thursday, August 1<sup>st</sup>.
3. Teams will be comprised of 2 or 3 team members, your choice. At least one team member must be 18 or older.
4. The chairpersons will host a video meeting using Google Meet to announce the 2024 Project G Street theme and answer questions on Friday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:00 pm. All contestants will be emailed a link to join. *At least one member of each team must attend the meeting.*
5. At least one team member must pick up your team's materials packet at G Street Fabrics during store hours August 3<sup>rd</sup>-9<sup>th</sup>. The packet will have your team's fabrics and a \$25 G Street Fabrics gift card for you to purchase notions. NO OTHER FABRIC CAN BE USED. The \$25.00 gift card can be used for any items you would need for the outfit that were not included (thread, closures, etc.) You may make or use your own patterns. *You do not need to purchase patterns with the gift card.*
6. One team member may be the model, or you may choose someone else to be your model. To ensure uniformity, the model must be a woman 18 or older. Models must bring their own shoes. Any other accents such as purses, hats or scarves must be made with your team's materials.
7. Contestants must provide the tools and machines to create their outfits. You may choose to bring: sewing machines, serger, dress form, irons, mirror, steamer, etc. Items can be dropped off at Heritage Hall starting at 8 am on Project G Street day: Saturday, August 10<sup>th</sup>. Directions and parking will be discussed at the video meeting.
8. Teams will construct their outfits in Heritage Hall from 8:30 am to 5:30 pm on Saturday, August 10<sup>th</sup>. The outfits will be judged on the following: interpretation of the theme; design (selection of style, color & material combinations); creativity (use of fabric, trim, closures); fit of outfit on the model; styling (accessories, hairstyle, the way you put together the whole look). *The judge's decision is final.*
9. All outfits will remain at the fair to be on display in the Home Arts building during fair week.
10. Breakfast and lunch can be purchased at the fair. No food is allowed in the sewing area.
